





#### **Understanding mental disorders**

Mental illness and mental disorders are widely used as synonyms, which is basically why society thinks that all mentally ill people go to mental asylums. But these terms differ A LOT in terms of meaning and scope. Mental disorder is a term used by the Mental Health Act to describe particular symptoms of an individual.

Normally, a person receives treatment for mental illness as a voluntary patient. Being a voluntary patient means they agree to have treatment for their illness and they have the right to stop that treatment if they are being treated in hospital, they have the right to leave at any time. But for people suffering from mental disorders, this right is taken away. The Mental Health Act (Compulsory Assessment and Treatment) applies to those situations where a person needs treatment for a mental disorder and they don't agree to it.

The Mental Health Act defines mental disorder as an abnormal state of mind to a degree that the individual can become a threat to himself or the health and life of others. Examples include being very depressed or on a "high", hearing voices or seeing things that no one else can hear or see, being unable to control impulses or impairment of memory or judgement.

#### Understanding behavioural disorders

Behavioural disorders are a quite common issue. At one point or another, all of us have shown some symptoms of behavioural disorders which may include putting blame on others, getting annoyed or nervous easily, inattention, hyperactivity, arguing, throwing tantrums etc. But if these symptoms are persistent and kept untreated it can severely impact negatively on a person's ability to make commitments at work, studies or relationships.

Since these disorders are very common, they are treatable and easily diagnosed but equally important to recover from. These disorders make it difficult for a person to collaborate, interact and thus grow. These symptoms are usually visible in childhood but can also develop in dynamic environments like in colleges.

#### **Understanding emotional disorders**

As Dr Jahangir said in "Dear Zindagi", as children we were never allowed to express ourselves as we wanted to. If we wanted to cry "ijazat nahi hai", "sara emotional system hi bigad gya". Only a person truly experiencing these conditions knows the hardships of these struggles. We need to understand the true meaning of these words, use them cautiously and help those in actual need.


### Question: What advice would you give to students in college to maximize their future success?





